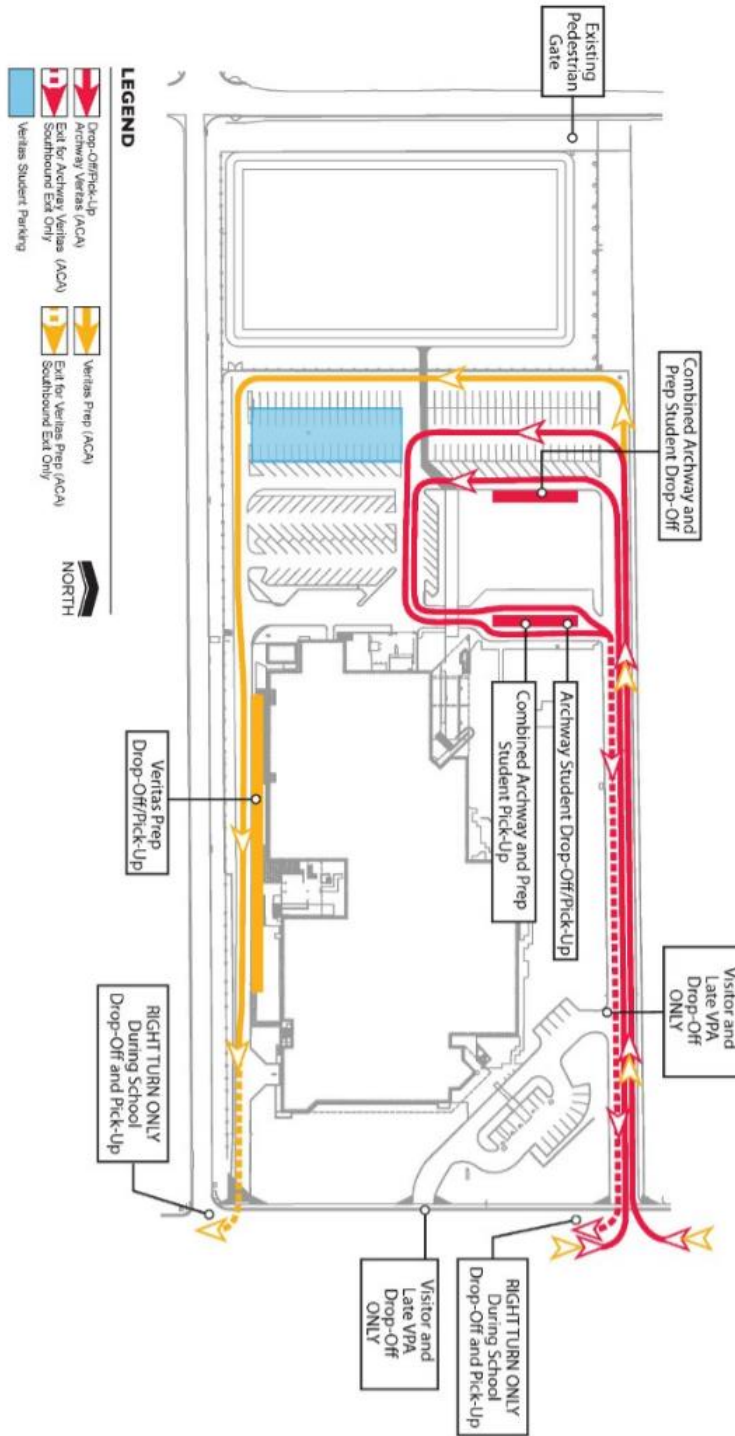

### Welcome to the Health Office at Archway Classical Academy Veritas!

#### Maintain health records of all students – this includes:

- Immunizations - please make sure your child's are up to date *before* school starts
- Health history – this includes medical diagnoses, surgeries, current medications (given at home as well as school), allergies (seasonal, drug, food, life threatening), and any other pertinent health information about your child.

**Assess and treat illness or injury** – Whether it's a scraped knee, tummy ache, fever, or more serious issue such as allergic reaction, broken bone or concussion - I am the first responder to any medical need.

**Monitor & treat chronic health conditions** – such as asthma, diabetes, seizure disorders, severe allergies, etc.

#### Monitor illness “outbreaks” –

- Students will be sent home from school with a temperature of 100.4 or higher. The student may not return to school until he/she is fever free **WITHOUT** medication for 24hrs to ensure that he/she is no longer contagious.
- Vomiting, Persistent abdominal pain, Open lesions and appearing very ill in school - a parent will be notified to pick up the student. Students may return 24 hours from the last episode of diarrhea or vomiting.
- If several students are diagnosed with a communicable illness (such as strep throat, flu), I will email you to heighten your awareness of symptoms. Don't forget to call me if your child is diagnosed with a communicable illness!

**Hearing and vision screenings** – Students in K, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, new students and previous hearing screen referrals are screened routinely at the beginning of the year. However, screenings can be performed at any time for any student if a parent or teacher expresses concern.

#### Administer Medication -

All medications (prescription and over the counter) must be kept in the nurse's office and in their original container. **Medications MUST be hand delivered by a parent or designee and the medication authorization form must be completed.** All forms can be found on our website or in my office.

- Prescription Medication: We can only accept (unexpired) medication in the original container with a readable prescription label attached.
- Asthma, allergy, diabetes, seizure conditions or any other chronic condition will require management plans completed by the prescribing physician. These forms can be found on our website, in my office or your physician may use their own form.
- Archway Veritas has a supply of OTC medications: Ibuprofen, Tylenol, Benadryl, Clear Eyes Drops, Neosporin, Hydrocortisone Cream, Tums.

**Uniforms-** I maintain a small supply of uniforms for toileting accidents, falls in the mud or torn pants. Donations of used uniforms, particularly smaller sizes as well as bike shorts, socks and belts are always welcome. **Please remember to return the borrowed uniforms after washing them!**

Feel free to contact me if you have any questions regarding the medication administration procedure or to discuss any other health concerns you may have.

#### **The invitation code: AVPSO56**

If your child will be in kindergarten in the 2017/2018 school year please select “PK – Incoming Kindergarten” as your grade level.

All new families in grade 1-5 - please select “INT” as your grade level.

All other grade levels will be automatically “graduated” to the next grade level over the summer, but you will need to confirm your contact information and the teacher once school resumes in the fall.

Once you register you will want to download the app, which is more user-friendly than the website.

#### Volunteer Opportunities

MSA is also your central point of contact for volunteer opportunities. Volunteering time is one of the best ways to connect with other parents and to learn more about the inner workings of the school and its events. We currently have an online sign-up list for committees and events for the 2017/2018 school year, found in MSA under “sign-ups.” We ask that each family commit to a minimum of 3 volunteer hours per semester so that our community will remain united and vibrant and so that we can support the school and faculty.

#### Events

### August:

*Meet the Teacher Night* is an open house style evening allowing you and your child to meet their teacher; a chance for your child to locate, organize his/her desk, and to drop off all books and supplies before school starts.

*Curriculum Night* is a formal teacher led introduction to the curriculum and classroom expectations – Parents only.

### September:

*Book Fair* is a literary themed week, offering the chance to purchase new and/or used books through a PSO organized event.

### October:

*Father-Daughter Dance* is a chance for the girls to take center stage. Despite the name, we welcome all parents to this event.

### November:

*Veritas 5K Victory Run* is fun run open to the entire family. This event is held in conjunction with Veritas Prep. Medals are awarded to the fastest runners in all age groups.
